SOUTHEND ON SEA

We will depart Surrey and head towards Essex, originally the "south end" of the village of Prittlewell, Southend was home to a few poor fishermens' huts and farms at the southern extremity of Prittlewell Priory land. In the 1790s, landowner Daniel Scratton sold off land on either side of what was to become the High Street. After the coming of the railways in the 19th century and the visit of Princess Caroline of Brunswick, Southend's status as a seaside resort grew. During the 19th century Southend's worlds longest pier was first constructed and the Clifftown development built,^[4] attracting many summer tourists to its seven miles of beaches and sea bathing.
