

# KENT MINING MUESUM

After much anticipation the long-awaited Kent Mining Museum has finally opened its doors to the general public. The first facility of its kind in Kent, the museum tells the story of the Kent Coalfield in the voices of the community themselves, including working life, community and the legacy of the coalfield. The current temporary exhibition is called The Migrating Miner and covers the story of those who migrated to the Kent Coalfield to find work and start their new life. Enjoy a 45 – 60-minute guided tour which includes archival objects not normally on display, and Meet a Miner experience, where you will be joined by one of the ex-miner volunteers where he talks about his experiences, life and work within the Kent Coalfield
