PETWORTH HOUSE

Petworth House is a late 17th century Grade 1 listed country house in the Parish of Petworth, West Sussex. The original manor house dates back to the12th century but was rebuilt in 1688 by Charles Seymour, 6th Duke of Somerset. The house has a magnificent fine art collection including works by Van Dyck, Turner and Gainsborough. Capability Brown designed the gardens with serpentine paths and flower beds. There are the woodlands to wander through together with the Deer Park with the fallow deer and beautiful views of the South Downs and the lakes. The mid 18th servants quarters houses interesting steam technology together with the café which offers hot and cold drinks, lunches, cake and afternoon tea and has both indoor and outdoor seating.
