

HAM HOUSE

Ham House was originally built in 1610, and was later transformed by the Duke and Duchess of Lauderdale into one of the grandest Stuart houses in England. The house which is nestled on the banks of the River Thames and is frequently used as a film location, has a well preserved interior and contains a unique collection of artwork and many rare cabinets. You can explore the formal gardens and the kitchen walled garden which dates back to the 1600's. Or if you prefer you can spend time in the comfortable Orangery Café for refreshments which is in one of the 17th century outbuildings and visit the gift shop which is located in the old bakehouse and laundry.
