Osterley Park is a neo-classical mansion which was originally Tudor built in the 1570's by Sir Thomas Gresham. The house was later bought by the banker Sir Francis Child in 1713. This beautiful Georgian Mansion in West London has one of the most complete interiors by Robert Adam and contains many treasures and antiquities to enjoy. Outside you can wander through the parkland and restored formal gardens with herbaceous borders, roses and ornamental vegetable beds and for refreshment visit the Stable café serving hot and cold food.
