## **BURWASH EAST SUSSEX**

Bateman's was built in 1634 and was the home of Rudyard Kipling and is set in the wooded landscape of the Sussex Weald. The 17<sup>th</sup> century house remains much the same as when Kipling lived there with its oak beams and mullion windows. The gardens in February are tranquil and have delightful displays of many different varieties of snowdrops which are beautiful to see. The Mulberry Garden tea room serves drinks, cake and light lunches and the Oast House shop is filled with gifts and Kipling books. There is also a second hand bookshop for the book lover to enjoy.
