


# STRAWBERRY HILL HOUSE

Horace Walpole built Strawberry Hill House in Twickenham in the 18th century around 1717, and at that time the house overlooked the River Thames. The house is a fine example of Georgian Gothic revival architecture and is home to many important paintings and objects. Walpole created a five acre romantic garden to compliment his Gothic castle. The gardens encompass flower beds, groves and woodlands all relaxing to wander through. The Garden Café occupies the Great Cloister of Strawberry Hill House and has beautiful views across the naturalistic garden. It has a unique setting in the Gothic Castle and an experience not too be missed.
