

SHAW HOUSE, NEWBURY

We start our journey to Newbury and to Shaw House which is a beautiful preserved Elizabethan house built in 1582 by the wealthy cloth merchant Thomas Dolman. It is famous as King Charles I's headquarters during the Battle of Newbury and over time Shaw House has entertained royalty, most notably Elizabeth I and was involved in the Civil War and more lately housed soldiers during World War II. There is much to learn about the architecture and the people that have inhabited this grade 1 listed house which is well worth a visit.
