POLESDEN LACY

Polesden Lacey is an Edwardian house located on the North Downs and it is owned and run by the National Trust. The Regency house was expanded from an earlier building and was extensively remodelled in 1906 by Margaret Greville. She was a well-known Edwardian hostess, and her collection of fine paintings, furniture, porcelain and silver is displayed throughout the house together with many other treasures. The 1400-acre estates include a walled rose garden where you can sit or you can wander through the ancient woodlands. The Coffee Shop is a great place to buy hot and cold drinks, cakes and snacks.
