

SAFFRON WALDEN, ESSEX

Saffron Walden is an ancient market village that has the remains of a Norman castle, a very large church, lots of old buildings, a great museum, and some old fortifications. The town centre is a very compact middle of old medieval street layouts. It's a mix of mostly old buildings with a few modern intrusions. There are lots of independent traders and small shops, Saffron Walden Museum, and the Fry Art Gallery. One thing to see are the buildings with plaster decoration surviving on the outside (pargeting). It's a fascinating place and well worth a visit.
