

# A TRIP TO KNEBWORTH HOUSE

Knebworth House is a Grade II English country house and has been the home of the Lytton family since 1490. Its most famous resident was Edward Bulwer-Lytton, a Victorian author and statesman. In the surrounding parkland is the medieval St Mary's Church and the Lytton family mausoleum. This beautiful gothic mansion is set in 28 acres with delightful gardens including a maze, walled vegetable garden and herb garden. There are many antiques, artworks and treasures to see in the house which has been used on many occasions as a film location. The Garden Terrace Tea Room offers light refreshments there is the traditional gift shop to visit.
