

THE HORNIMANS MUSEUM

The Horniman Museum and Gardens is an inspiring attraction with over 16 acre gardens to see in South London's Forest Hill. The Museum has been open since Victorian times, when Frederick John Horniman first opened his house and extraordinary collection of objects to visitors. Since then, the collection has grown tenfold and includes internationally important collections of anthropology and musical instruments, as well as an acclaimed aquarium and natural history collection. Unusually for such an important museum, you can see the collection up-close and face-to-face. You can even pick up, try on and play with some objects. Your visit includes at entry to the butterfly house at Midday.
