

WHITCHURCH SILK MILL

Whitchurch Silk Mill is an industrial heritage museum in Hampshire. It is the oldest working silk mill in its original building and is widely recognised as a hub of engineering and craft, using historic machinery and meticulous skills. It produces a range of silk products and has done so for more than 200 years. The mill has been operating as a living museum for the last 35 years and uses historic looms, employing one of only four silk ribbon weavers still working. We will be given a guided tour of the mill followed by a light lunch in their café and time to spend in the gift shop.
