

WINCHESTER GREAT HALL AND WESTGATE MUSEUM

Built by William the Conqueror, Winchester Castle was the seat of power of medieval monarchs. The Great Hall, one of the finest medieval halls in England, and the Westgate, which served as the castle's primary defence, are now the sole survivors of this once magnificent historical site. Westgate Museum is housed inside a surviving, fortified medieval gateway and the museum tells the story of this remarkable building and the history of Tudor and Stuart Winchester. It also offers unrivalled views over the city from its roof. A debtors' prison for 150 years, this beautifully refurbished, ancient scheduled monument is the last of the main medieval gates into the city. The museum displays include a famous collection of pre-imperial weights and measures, and a fine painted ceiling commissioned in anticipation of a visit by Mary Tudor and Philip of Spain on the occasion of their marriage in Winchester in 1554. After the museum you can spend time exploring the cathedral and the shops before returning home after a lovely day out.
