

ELTHAM PALACE, LONDON

Eltham Palace is a spectacular Art Deco dwelling built in 1936 by Stephen and Virginia Courtauld. It was constructed alongside the medieval Great Hall of Eltham Palace which was once the centre of royal life where Henry VIII spent his childhood. The Courtaulds created a masterpiece of modern art deco interiors with an amazing entrance hall, sumptuous dining room, and many other illustrious living areas. As you experience the wonderful interiors you step for a complete contrast from the art deco era into the 1470's and into the Great Hall which was part of the medieval royal palace. There are also beautiful gardens to wander through and enjoy and not to be missed the pretty café in the glasshouse for refreshments and the gift shop.
