This beautiful 16<sup>th</sup> century mansion and estate is settled in the rolling hills of the Chilterns. Greys Court has been home to many powerful families for nearly a thousand years, and until recently was home to the Brunner family. The house offers a welcoming atmosphere, and you can enjoy the surviving parts of the Tudor house with its many homely rooms to explore. The beautiful grounds include the walled gardens which provide a colourful patchwork all set in and around the medieval ruins. The Great Tower dates to the 14<sup>th</sup> century and there is a donkey wheel which was in use until the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. Refreshments can be found in the newly refurbished Cow Shed tearoom.
