

# PARHAM HOUSE & GARDENS, SUSSEX

## Itinerary

Parham House is a Grade II Elizabethan Manor House nestled at the foot of the South Downs in West Sussex, in the heart of an ancient deer park. The traditional Elizabethan E shaped stone mansion was first built in 1557 and has remained a family home, with only three families living there since the sixteenth century. It has an impressive collection of needlework, beautiful paintings and furniture. Its impressive Long Gallery is 158 feet in length and is one of the longest in existent. The house has many interesting features together with its seven acres of beautiful grounds to wander through and the award-winning walled garden. There is of course a lovely café for light refreshments and gift shop.
