

A Day at Herne Bay

Enjoy a day at Herne Bay, a seaside town on the north coast of Kent in Southeast England. It is 6 miles (10 km) north of Canterbury and 4 miles (6 km) east of Whitstable. It neighbours the ancient villages of Herne and Reculver which are all part of the City of Canterbury. Herne Bays' seafront is lovely to stroll along taking in the sea air and enjoying the colourful gardens. It was also home to the world's first freestanding purpose-built Clock Tower,
