

# Michelham Priory House & Gardens, Sussex

## Itinerary

Discover the enchanting Michelham Priory and gardens an historic site in Sussex with a history of 800 years. The Priory is on the site of a former Augustin monastery which was established in 1229 by Augustinian canons. The east and north wings date from the 13<sup>th</sup> century and the west wing from the 16<sup>th</sup> century. It features the longest medieval moat, and the watermill has been restored to working order. There are interesting displays in the house and gatehouse which give immersive glimpses into all the different eras that have passed since it was built. The seven acres of stunning gardens are lovely to wander through with a stop at the cafe where you can enjoy homemade treats and a variety hot and cold foods. This interesting priory offers a wonderful blend of history and activities ensuring there is something for everyone to enjoy.
